Print and customize the annual sample flyer template to help promote your local National Night Out event this year.

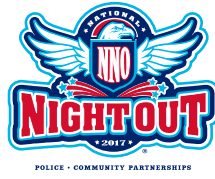

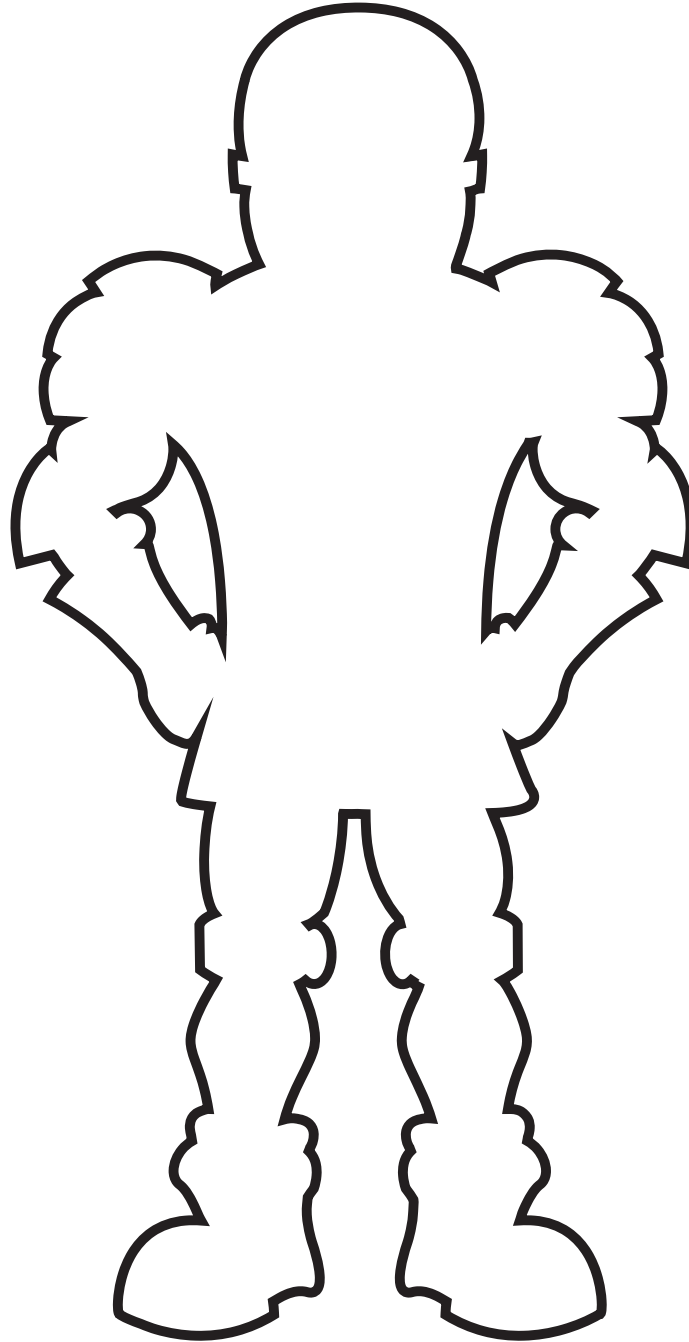
